# 1. General description

The 74LV244A is an 8-bit buffer/line driver with 3-state outputs. The device features two output enables (1<del>OE</del> and 2<del>OE</del>). A HIGH on n<del>OE</del> causes the associated outputs to assume a high-impedance OFF-state.

Inputs are overvoltage tolerant. This feature allows the use of these devices as translators in mixed voltage environments.

Schmitt-trigger action at all inputs makes the circuit tolerant of slower input rise and fall times.

This device is fully specified for partial power down applications using I<sub>OFF</sub>. The I<sub>OFF</sub> circuitry disables the output, preventing the potentially damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

### 2. Features and benefits

- Wide supply voltage range from 2.0 V to 5.5 V
- Maximum t<sub>pd</sub> of 6.5 ns at 5 V
- Typical  $V_{OL(p)}$  < 0.8 V at  $V_{CC}$  = 3.3 V,  $T_{amb}$  = 25 °C
- Typical  $V_{OH(v)}$  > 2.3 V at  $V_{CC}$  = 3.3 V,  $T_{amb}$  = 25 °C
- · Supports mixed-mode voltage operation on all ports
- I<sub>OFF</sub> circuitry provides partial Power-down mode operation
- Latch-up performance exceeds 250 mA per JESD 78 Class II
- ESD protection:
  - HBM: ANSI/ESDA/JEDEC JS-001 class 2 exceeds 3000 V
  - CDM: ANSI/ESDA/JEDEC JS-002 class C3 exceeds 2000 V
- Specified from -40 °C to +85 °C and from -40 °C to +125 °C

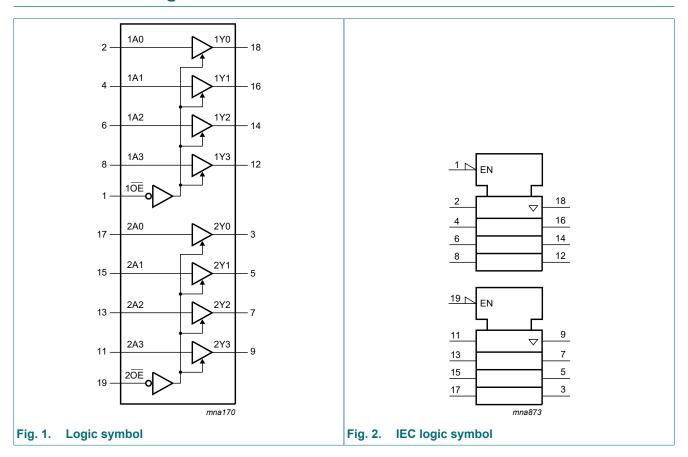

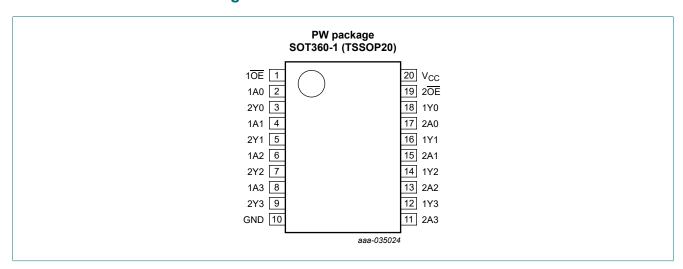

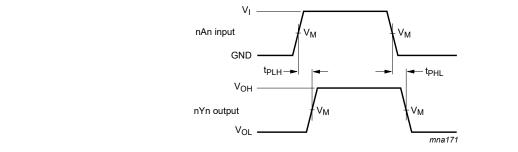

Fig. 3. Propagation delay input (nAn) to output (nYn)

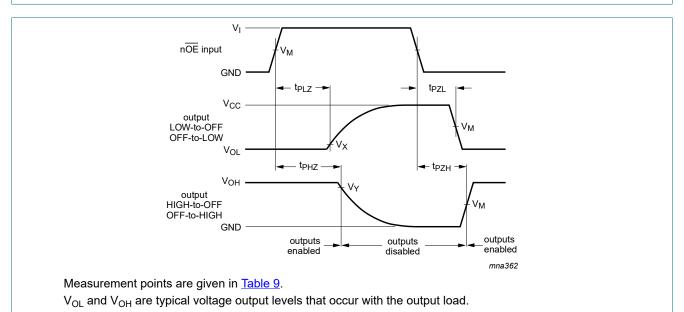
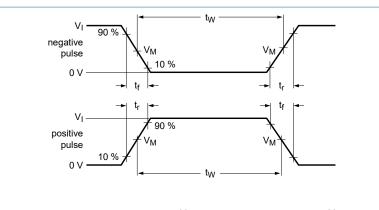


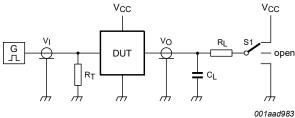
Fig. 4. Enable and disable times

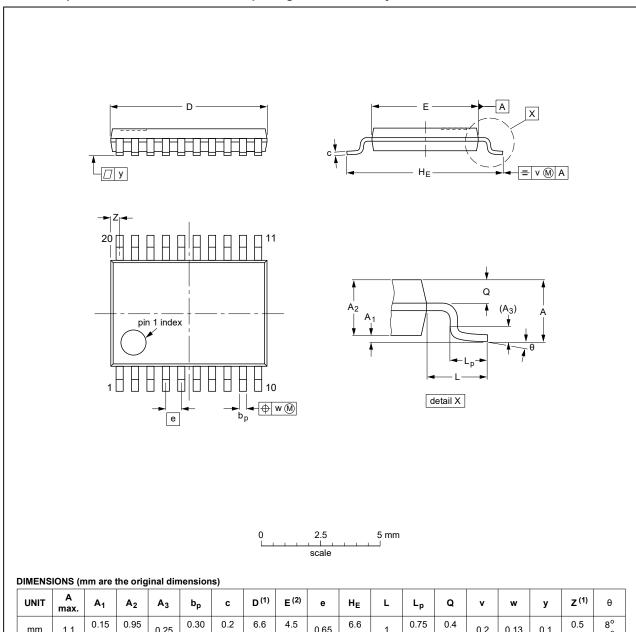
