




**Figure 1**Forward Characteristics




Reverse Characteristics




**Figure 3**Current Derating




**Figure 4**Power Derating




**Figure 5**Total Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage




**Figure 6**Capacitace vs. Reverse Voltage



**Figure 7**Capacitance Stored Energy




**Figure 8**Non Repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current versus Pulse Duration (sinsusoidal waveform)




**Figure 9**Transient Thermal Impedance


