



Figure 4. Forward Current Derating of Lead Temperature




Figure 5. Power Dissipation




Figure 6. Typical Forward Voltage




Figure 7. Typical Reverse Current\*




Figure 8. Typical Capacitance




Figure 9. Forward Current Derating of Lead Temperature




Figure 10. Power Dissipation















